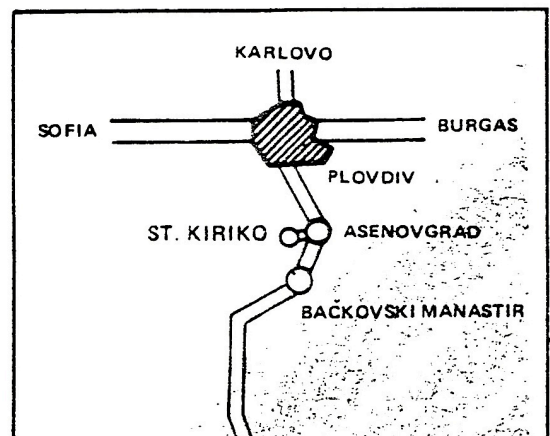

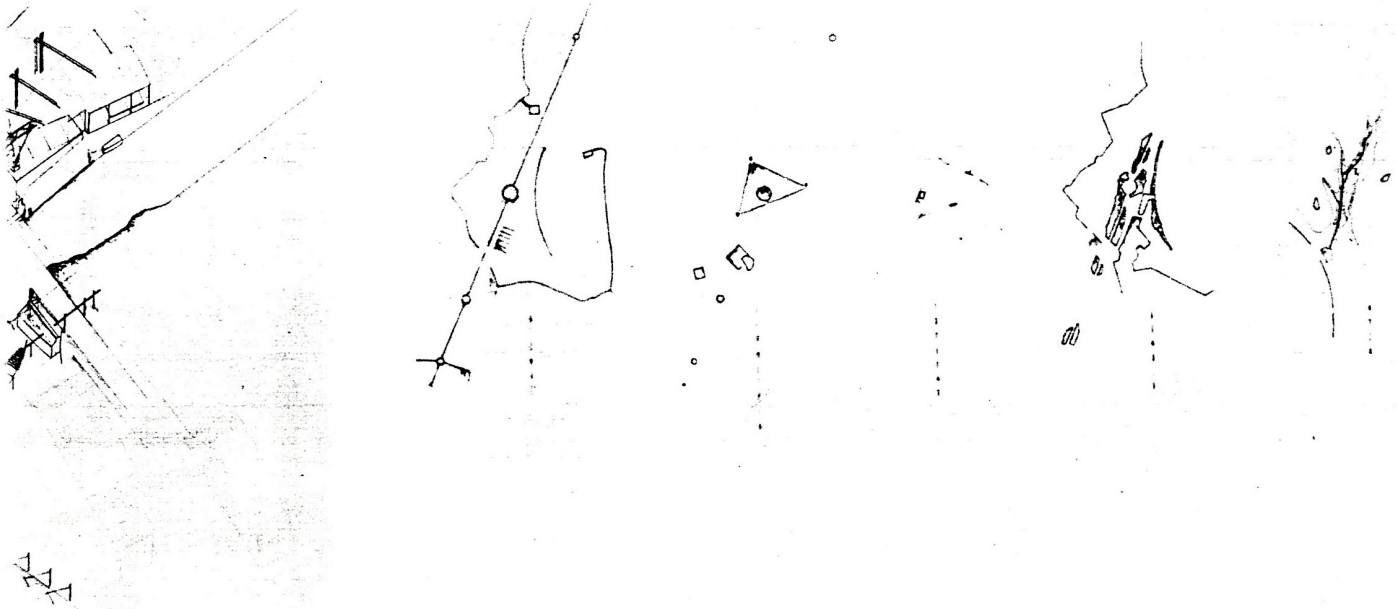

CITY WITH GREEN

METHOD: DECONSTRUCTIVISM

This is not a new idea. But new “materials” do exist though, which participate in the creative mixture in some eclectic prestructuring.

So . . . DO ECO – POLIS.

STRUCTURING:

The way of structuring reaches the edge of non-control use without going further. The proposed complexity is totally controllable.

DATA: The entrance. Connection.

The entrance moves towards the city.

The Axis. Continuity.

Indefinite limits of its ends.

The Centre. Management.

The Triangle. Disturbance and disbalance.

Allowed geometrical correlation – symbol.

Almost the complete number of elements of the fundamental base are following its trace.

The greenery. Crosses the city.

The Walk. An essential organic element of the axis.

The Relief. Defines.

Creates the basic prerequisite for the correlation with the “materials” of the city.

The Flank. Individual house.

1. Precise expression means LIVING /ECO/ in a city /POLIS/. LIVING IN THE CITY.

2. The structural foundation of the city is essentially based on the environment.

3. Man lives together with the city, the city lives together with nature.

4. Prestructuring.
